Does God care about me?

PROVERBS 3:5-6

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. ⁶In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.

Do you ever feel like no one cares about you? When hard things happen, you might feel like you're all alone. But there is someone who always cares. That someone is God.

If you know the Lord Jesus Christ as your Savior, you can trust God to take care of you. Perhaps when you get home from school you have to be alone while your parents are at work.
